

Lorry-Mounted Crane (HIAB)

Hydrauliska Industri AB (Hiab) is a Finnish manufacturer of loader cranes, demountable container handlers, forestry cranes, truck-mounted forklifts and tail lifts. 'HIAB' (pronounced *high'-ab*) is often used as a synonym for a loader crane of any make.

All HIAB courses are conducted on site in the surroundings that delegates will be familiar with and on the equipment that they will be operating.

Designed for drivers of vehicles fitted with truck mounted cranes, this course will teach the basics for their safe operation.
