Power Press Setter Regulations

This course is covered legally by the Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations 1998 and advises on the precautions that should be taken to ensure safe use of power presses, thereby preventing accidents.

Power presses are among the most dangerous machines used in industry. Amputation or serious injury usually results from accidents caused by becoming trapped between the tools of a power press.
