Course content

- Initial assessment of the casualty
- Care of the unconscious casualty
- Resuscitation procedures
- Asthma and diabetic problems
- Choking
- Head injuries including neck and spinal injuries
- Seizures including epilepsy and febrile convulsions
- Sprains, strains and fractures
- Poisoning, bites and stings
- Bleeding and shock/burns and scolds/electric shock
- Foreign objects
- Childhood conditions (e.g. measles, meningitis, croup)
- First aid kit and administration of medicine
- Priorities of treatment
- Basic life support skills (Airway, Breathing, Circulation)
- Using the standard contents of a first aid kit
