A plant maintenance engineer plays a crucial role in ensuring the reliable operation of machinery and equipment within an industrial plant, contributing to the overall productivity, efficiency, and profitability of the facility. They must possess a strong technical aptitude, problem-solving skills, and a proactive approach to maintenance management.
